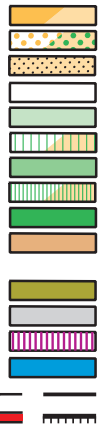

### ORIENTEERING

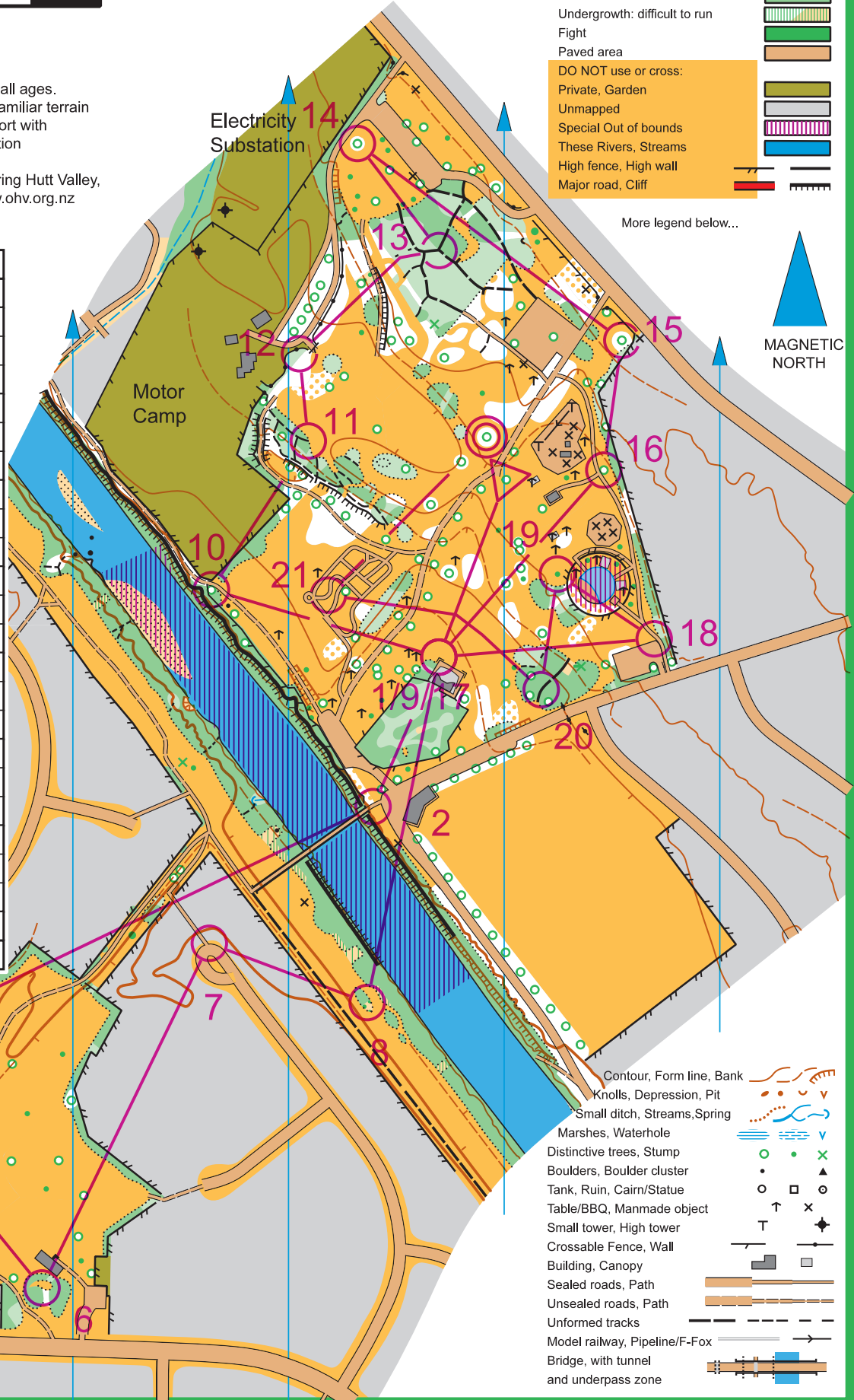
